

## Brief artistic history

My name is Romano Mosconi and I live in Galliera Veneta, a small town in the north of the province of Padua. I have taught business economics and economic sociology at various universities and worked as a chartered accountant and economic journalist. Despite my busy professional life, I have always found time for painting, a passion that has accompanied me throughout my life. After some early experiences, my exhibition activity resumed in 2015 (October 3-18) with an important solo exhibition at the Palazzo Pretorio in San Sepolcro (AR). The following year (2016), by resolution of the City Council, a permanent exhibition of my paintings was established at the Municipal Library of Badia Tedalda (AR) with the title: 'L'Economista pittore' (The Economist Painter). Subsequently, before my exhibition activity was interrupted due to COVID, I participated in a group exhibition in Rossano Veneto (VI) (December 21, 2019) entitled 'Rossano dipinge' (Rossano Paints). Exhibition activity resumed in 2022 (September 28-October 11) in Veneto at the Nobili Cappello hall of the Villa Imperiale in Galliera Veneta (PD) and then (November 3, 2022) on television with a report by a Brazilian television station via video teleconference.

This was followed by solo and group exhibitions in 2023 in Galliera Veneta and Fontaniva (PD), then again in Galliera Veneta in 2024, and then in 2025 in Alzano Lombardo, Galliera Veneta, Vietri sul Mare, Venice (Palazzo Pisani Revedin), and Capri. Finally, it is worth noting the media coverage given to the

works exhibited in the 2024 solo exhibition, with Rete Veneta television news reporting on it for an entire weekend.
